In order to facilitate this change, a board of directors was needed to take on the financial and legal responsibilities of the organization. We needed a group of people who care about what the organization does and want to help steer the organization, develop budgets and mandates for our operations, and provide checks and balances for staff and volunteers.

In November 2016 Ayesha Barmania started recruiting for a planning committee. They were looking for anyone who was willing to volunteer an hour a month to meet up and plan out how the organization is going to take form. Think of it as a proto-board. Members of this planning committee will help form the corporation's bylaws, as well as help plan out the financial structure of the organization to fit with the structure of a non-profit corporation.
